Options for sources of funding



Timing is critical

- The critical issue for the timing of any funding decision is not Treasury process deadlines but the need to launch the Call for Ideas design selection process.
- If the memorial is to be completed by May 2020, the *Call for Ideas* will need to begin in October 2018. A decision on both site and budget is required.

How will the funding be secured?

Site

A decision on the site is needed in order to launch the Call for Ideas

- We have sought your confirmation that you support the Parnell Rose Gardens as the preferred site for the memorial. See BR2018/471.
- MCH is working with Auckland Council to get agreement in principle for this site, contingent on you confirming your preference.

Design Selection Panel

Who will chair the panel?

- We have nominations for two of the positions and are working with Auckland Council on nominations for two more. These four positions provide the requisite technical expertise architect, landscape architect, urban designer, arts professional such as curator.

- We have recommended [BR2018/471] that the panel and seek your views on whether you would like us to advance this idea.

 This will be arranged to take place before the 28 November meeting.

Next steps

- The matters raised above are for discussion at the meeting with officials on 12 September.
- We will prepare a Cabinet paper either seeking a specific amount you are comfortable with or providing a range of cost options for your Cabinet colleagues to decide from.
