Operating costs	\$434,562.94

The total spend as at 31 July 2022 is \$2,463,839.17 (this is the total costs including those not supplied in the breakdown above). Project management costs, security costs and costs to keep the main contractor on standby are being withheld under section 9(2)(b)(ii) of the OIA to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information. As you have been advised in your last request for information on the cost of the National Erebus Memorial, going forward, our intention is to update this figure at the end of each Financial Year quarter.
